EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

We are a 501(c)3 public charity with the goal of becoming the digital oversight and reporting mechanism of our Constitutional Republic, to ensure our government's integrity to We The People remains intact. EDUCATION INITIATIVE

GOALS: FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- Empower parents and communities to make more informed decisions regarding the curriculums that are used in their schools.
 - Redefine the value of an education in terms of skillsets that are needed in the job market and modern life.
- Facilitate the exploration of career paths to help children learn about jobs and what skills are required to get hired.
 - Empower students to be more active in the decision making of their education as it relates to the jobs they want and where to find the skills they need.
- Check if school districts are following Florida laws (HB 1467, HB 1557, HB 7).
 - Protecting the minds, innocence, and futures of our children. Exercising our legal rights against anyone who breaks our laws sets a precedent that our government cannot operate above the law and without the approval of its community.

THE ANALYSIS AND PILOT STUDY

- Analyze high school curriculums to assess the real-world skills that children are being taught in the 15 largest counties in Florida. This includes 3 of the largest school districts in the US. The counties include: Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Hillsborough, Orange, Duval, Pinellas, Lee, Polk, Brevard, Pasco, Volusia, Seminole, Sarasota, and Osceola.
- Analyze the required skills in the current job market for entry level positions with a high school diploma, an associate's degree, and a bachelor's degree.
- Compare the skills being taught to the skills that are required in our current workforce to understand the skill gap that exists between what's taught and what's needed.
- Communicate with school boards about their compliance with Florida law.

DELIVERABLES

- Determine the top 10 technical skills and top 10 common skills in our economy, present them in the context of the top 10 occupation groups in the US and each county.
- Identify up to 25 occupations with detailed skills-based analysis as it relates to entry-level experience requirements.
- Analyze up to 15 curriculums from each county.
- Determine the skillsets that are being taught in curriculums and their value in our economy.



- Present the skillset gaps that exist between high school curriculums and entry level jobs requiring a minimum of a high school diploma, associate's degree, or bachelor's degree.
- Provide updates on the shifting trends of required skillsets in the job market.
- Identify the opportunities for improvement in curriculums to better prepare young people to enter the workforce.
- Provide an app on our website that shows career paths, the skills that are required for each job, and where to acquire those skills.

POST-STUDY STEPS

- Provide our study to the public so each community and its school board can work together to improve curriculums to teach more relevant skills and increase the likelihood of success for their young people.
- Find and propose alternative curriculums that teach skills that are missing from current curriculums.
- Communicate the process for communities to have more involvement in their school system.
- Create national awareness about our Skills Readiness Program to fundraise for more studies and assist communities across the country.

WHERE DO WE START

- Our Pilot study will focus on Miami-Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach counties before proceeding to others. We aim to include public schools, charter schools, religious schools, and trade schools in our curriculum analysis.
